This year, Brilla Schools Network wished their very first graduating class well as they headed off to college. **93% of Brilla's Class of 2021 are headed to excellent colleges and universities** like: Fairfield University, Seton Hall, Temple University, CUNY Lehman, Buffalo State University, and more!

High School Success for Scholars

Starletta, a student with significant learning needs, is being raised by her 22-year-old sister. Initially denied admission to a Catholic high school due to limited IEP accommodations, her exceptional interpersonal skills made a lasting impression. When a seat became available, the high school eagerly offered her the spot. With the support of a **state voucher, scholarships, and financial aid**, Starletta is now a freshman at **Mount Notre Dame**, attending with **little to no cost to her family**.



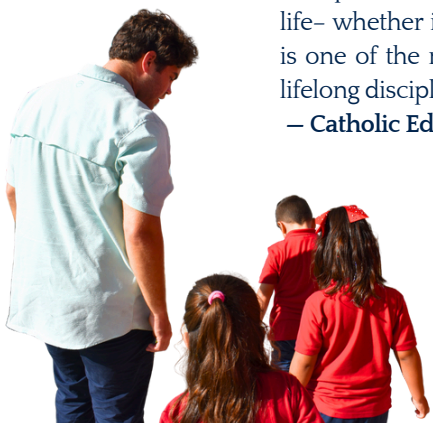
Raising Up Faithful Men in Education

Our **Seton Teaching Fellows (STF)** Program continues to lead the way in faith-centered service and education. This year, we saw a **15.79% increase in male recruitment**, with men now representing 38% of the cohort, significantly higher than the national average of just 23% male educators in K-12 schools.

Our male STFs are more than teachers. They are **spiritual mentors, community leaders, and living witnesses of Christ** in neighborhoods where male role models of faith are often absent.

Rooted in the belief that **every child possesses inherent dignity and infinite potential**, we remain deeply committed to serving **every child**. As the number of scholars with IEPs increases, we continue to innovate and adapt, ensuring every child receives the support they need to thrive body, mind, and soul. Additionally, this year, Brillante became the first Seton school to offer El Camino to PreK3, nourishing children spiritually even earlier.
